# COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

(AS OF 28 APRIL 2022)

All travellers arriving into Kenya through any point of entry must have a certificate of COVID-19 vaccination. [COVID-19 protocol](#)

All travellers coming to Kenya who are fully vaccinated shall be exempt from the requirement of a PCR test. All eligible unvaccinated travellers arriving at any port of entry into Kenya, must be in possession of a valid COVID-19 negative PCR test certificate conducted within 72 hours before departure regardless of the route of entry. Children below the age of five (5) years are exempt from this requirement.

Passengers travelling to Kenya are required to fill in the **COVID-19 Travelers Health Surveillance Form** online [https://ears.health.go.ke/airline\\_registration/](https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/). Passengers will be required to display the received QR codes to port health officials for them to be allowed to proceed to arrival immigration. You can also complete the form by downloading the “**Jitenge MoH Kenya**” App on Play Store or Apple Store and Signing up as Air Traveller.

## **Please also find measures to note listed by the Ministry of Health Kenya:**

- Maintain 1.5-metres of distance from one another
- Wear your face mask at all times
- **Have a valid COVID19 free certificate (taken 96 hours before travel) as per Ministry of Health guidelines**
- Wash your hands and sanitize regularly
- Cough and sneeze into the inside of your elbow
- Use paper tissues and throw them away after you blow your nose
- Avoid shaking hands
- Make contactless payments

# PCR TEST

For those traveling out of Nairobi at the end of the Summit, kindly note that your next destination may require a PCR test. Some facilities providing a PCR test are:

# DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE AND AIR TICKETS

## (UN Staff)

All UN participants should be provided by their agencies with daily subsistence allowance (DSA) based on Agencies respective rules & regulations.

## VISAS

Kenya does not issue visas on arrival. Foreign visitors must now apply for an e-Visa in advance. The visa on arrival for Kenya was discontinued at the end of 2020. From January 1, 2021, visas are only available online - see link below

- UNLP and diplomatic passports holders will be granted Courtesy Entry visas upon arrival. Courtesy Entry Visa Issued to Diplomatic, Official and Service passport holders on official duties, or on transit for official business or duties. It is issued free of charge / gratis.
- E-Visa: Visitors to the Republic of Kenya can now apply for their eVisa services <https://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html>
- Single Entry Visa: Issued for single entry to persons whose nationalities require a visa to enter Kenya either for business, tourism, medical or other reasons.

Basic Requirements: Valid travel document not less than six months; Return ticket.

### Visa Fees

Currently \$51. Card handling fee will be surcharged for Debit cards, Credit cards, VISA, Mastercard.

# EXCHANGE RATE AND CURRENCY

The main currency used in Kenya is the shilling (KShs). There are no currency restrictions into or out of Kenya for currency transactions. Forex bureau are available both at the airport and at the city centre with various currencies being traded. Major Credit cards are also accepted e.g. Visa, MasterCard etc.

Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the hotel.

## TIME ZONE

GMT/UTC +3

## DRESS CODE

Business Casual (no tie) is appropriate during the Summit. Traditional National Dress is optional.

## POWER SUPPLIES

The most common electrical plug type in Kenya (and Safari Park Hotel) is the G type, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Kenya operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz.



## LANGUAGE AND INTERPRETATION

The official language of the meeting is English.

## WEATHER

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Nairobi in May is 14°C (57.2°F). The average maximum temperature lies around 25°C (77°F).

\*Home to over 100 mammal species, four of the Big Five (lion, Buffalo, leopard and rhino).
